

Scholarship Details

In order to be eligible to receive this scholarship an application must be completed and the student must be a Member of the Free Methodist church or attender recommended by a Harvest Conference Pastor.

The student must be attending a Free Methodist approved college, university, or seminary.

Students can receive \$750 per semester & are expected to request their local church to match, as well as the Free Methodist college, university, or seminary they are attending.

Students should also be aware of the ability to earn loan forgiveness.



Loan Forgiveness/ Ministry Service Credits

Through supervised, purposeful, and transformational service, Free Methodist students become consistent community contributors. Students can earn credits to turn the Scholarship loan into a grant according to the following guidelines:

- 5 Credits—1 day of service (5+ hrs in 1 day)
- 10 Credits—2 day or weekend service project (each day 5+ hrs)
- 15-30 Credits—semester of weekly involvement (generally 1-2 hrs a week totaling 15-30 hrs of service)
- 30-100 Credits—Intensive weeklong, summerlong service or increased responsibility roughly equivalent to 40+ Hrs
- 40+ Credits = minimum credits per/year to turn a loan into a grant.

Verifying Your Service Credits

- Letter or email from your supervising person.
- Their signature on your service sheet.

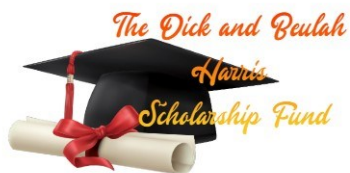
